

By the Judgment of 8th July, 2014 No. 21-II/2014 the Constitutional Court gave appraisal of constitutionality of Sub-Item “r” of Item 18 of the Rules of Granting Young Families Social Payments for Acquisition (Building) of Housing and Their Use (approved by the Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation of 17th December, 2010 No. 1050).

The contested normative provision was the subject-matter of consideration as serving as basis for exclusion of a young family recognized as needing amelioration of living conditions from the number of participants of the sub-programme “Providing Young Families with Housing” of the federal purposeful programme “Housing” for 2011-2015 in connection with direction of means of maternal (family) capital by it at amelioration of living conditions.

The Constitutional Court recognized this normative provision as not contradicting the Constitution of the Russian Federation so far as it contemplates no exclusion from the number of participants of the indicated sub-programme of a young family having children, which has directed the means of maternal (family) capital at amelioration of living conditions prior to the receipt of social payment for acquisition (building) of housing.
