

**By the Judgment of 14 April 2022 No. 15-II/2022 the Constitutional Court assessed constitutionality of Article 213.25, item 3, of the Federal Law "On Insolvency (Bankruptcy)" and Article 446, part 1, item 8 of the Civil Procedure Code of the Russian Federation and Article 61, item 1 and Article 80, item 1 of the Family Code of the Russian Federation**

The said provisions became subject to examination insofar as they served as a basis for deciding on the exclusion from the bankruptcy estate of a citizen declared insolvent (bankrupt), funds totaling at least the established of the subsistence minimum for a minor child who is dependent on the citizen-debtor, in the absence of evidence of non-compliance by the other parent with the obligations to support the child.

The challenged provisions were recognized as not contravening the Constitution of the Russian Federation because they do not imply a refusal to exclude funds from the bankruptcy estate of a citizen declared insolvent (bankrupt) in these circumstances, including in the absence of evidence of the other parent's failure obligation to maintain a child in accordance with the Family Code of the Russian Federation.
