

By the Judgement of 16 October 2025 No.34-II, the Constitutional Court assessed constitutionality of Articles 20 and 21 of the Federal Law of 3 August 2018 No.289-FZ «On Customs Regulation in the Russian Federation and on Amendments to Certain Legislative Acts of the Russian Federation»

These legal provisions were the subject of consideration to the extent that, they serve as a basis for resolving the issue of determining the place of origin of goods for the purpose of paying duties, including anti-dumping duties in carrying out customs control upon importation of goods and if during the civil turnover of this product, the country of its destination and (or) information about the consignee changes in comparison with the original specified in the certificate of origin of this product.

The contested legal provisions were recognised as not contradicting the Constitution, since they do not exclude the possibility of determining for the purpose of paying anti-dumping duties (including on the basis of documents submitted to the customs authority and (or) control measures carried out by it) the country of origin of the goods on the basis of a certificate of origin in the specified case.
