

By the Judgement of 27 April 2026 No. 28-II, the Constitutional Court assessed constitutionality of Article 32 (item 1² of part 1) of the Federal Law No.400-FZ «On Insurance Pensions» of 28 December 2013

This legal provision was examined to the extent that it serves as a basis for resolving the issue of the early grant of an old-age insurance pension to a woman who is a citizen of the Russian Federation, in connection with the birth and upbringing by her of three children until they reach the age of eight, who are also citizens of the Russian Federation, where the children were born and raised up to that age outside the Russian Federation or the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic on territory that is currently the territory of a foreign state.

The contested legal provision was recognised as not contradicting the Constitution to the extent that it cannot serve as a basis for refusing to grant such a woman an early old-age insurance pension under these circumstances.

The judicial decisions adopted in the applicant's case on the basis of the contested legal provision as interpreted in a manner that diverges from its constitutional legal meaning as established in this Judgement, as well as judicial decisions in cases of other women who made the same claims and were refused on the same grounds, are subject to review in accordance with the established procedure, provided there are no other obstacles to such review.
